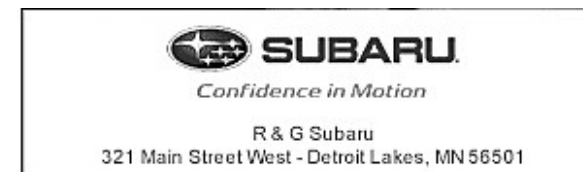

Dr. Tom Strait has been a member of the music faculty at Minnesota State University-Moorhead since 2001, where he teaches brass instruments and directs the MSUM Jazz Ensemble. Dr. Strait holds a Doctor of Arts degree in trumpet performance from the University of Northern Colorado as well as a degree from Henderson University and the University of Texas. Before coming to MSUM, Dr. Strait taught for several years at both the university and public school levels and served in the U.S. Air Force playing with the USAF Academy Falconaires. An active freelance trumpeter, he has performed with many artists including Bob Hope, Nancy Wilson, Natalie Cole, Doc Severinson and Randy Becker. Currently, he serves as principal trumpet with the Fargo-Moorhead Symphony Orchestra and is a member of the Post Traumatic Funk Syndrome. His past teachers include Donald Kramer, Raymond Crisara and William Pfund. Tom Strait is a Yamaha performing artist.
